Worldwide Ethiopian Action Fund (WEAF) is a 501C (4) non-profit organization established as a sister organization of AEPAC and registered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in May 2021 "to engage in fund raising, lobbying public relations and communication activities related to Ethiopia. Such activities are aimed at strengthening and promoting the historical relations between Ethiopia and the United States of America.

AEPAC receives donations ONLY from US citizens and US legal residents or Green Card holders. Donation to AEPAC is done on individual basis and maximum donation is \$5,000.00 in a calendar year.

WEAF receives donations of any amount of their choice from individuals and organizations from in the United States and other parts of the world. There is no US citizenship or legal residence restrictions to donate to WEAF.

PURPOSE

AEPAC and WEAF will collaborate with partners, stakeholders and Lobby and Public Relations Firms to:

Engage all three branches of the US government to create a Pro-Ethiopia environment at all levels of government.

Educate legislators and the US public at large to get a balanced view of the Ethiopian situation specifically the Tigray crisis and provide awareness of its inalienable right to build the Grand Renaissance Dam (GERD) to promote its development and create regional collaboration with downstream countries.

Neutralize the mis/disinformation and negative propaganda against Ethiopia.

Establish an Ethiopian caucus in the US congress.

Rally for win-win American-Ethiopian bilateral relations that promote diplomatic, economic, trade gains.
