This fall, it is crucial that we all participate in the voting process for two key reasons.

First, we can advocate for local issues, from improving neighborhood school systems to fostering business opportunities for entrepreneurs and shaping essential regulations. Second, we have the chance to influence U.S. policies that support stability, peace, and development in Ethiopia—a nation grappling with self-imposed challenges by its

### **2024** Congressional Endorsements

This weekend, AEPAC released its list of 2024 congressional endorsees, which will be updated as additional candidates receive approval from the national election committee and the AEPAC board. Each endorsed candidate will receive a letter from the American Ethiopian Public Affairs Committee outlining our endorsement and expressing our commitment to ongoing collaboration on both local issues and international matters related to Ethiopia. AEPAC chapters, in coordination with the national organization, will mobilize resources to support endorsed candidates in their respective regions. This is especially crucial in highly competitive states, often referred to as "swing states," including Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, New Hampshire, Minnesota, Arizona, Georgia, Virginia, Florida, Michigan, Nevada, Colorado, North Carolina, and Maine, where our efforts can influence the election outcome.

### **Gubernatorial Endorsement**

In the gubernatorial election,

AEPAC has endorsed Matt Meyer for Governor of Delaware. Mr. Meyer, who recently met in person with the AEPAC leadership team, is a strong ally of the Ethiopian American community in Delaware. He is dedicated to advancing freedom and entrepreneurship in Ethiopia, whether in his role within government or the private sector. In early September, AEPAC, in collaboration with colleagues from the Ballard Spahr firm, will host a fundraising event and campaign in support of Matt Meyer.

### **Engagement in Key States**

Pennsylvania, one of the key "swing states," has seen active engagement from AEPAC leadership, including two discussions with Senator Bob Casey. Senator Casey has requested endorsement and support from the Ethiopian American community both in Pennsylvania and across the country. AEPAC has endorsed Senator Casey, and further discussions with his campaign committee are ongoing.

### **Presidential Election Involvement**

As the presidential election approaches, AEPAC is actively working to engage with the foreign relations committees of both former President Trump and Vice President Harris to gather information on their US-Africa policies, particularly their stance on US-Ethiopia relations for 2025 and beyond. While a busy campaign may not initially focus on such issues, our collective voice as voters can ensure they do. This is why it's crucial for us to unite and make our voices heard. Let's seize this opportunity to influence the conversation.


